We would like to invite you to the 12<sup>th</sup> International Symposium on Geochemistry of the Earth's Surface (GES12), which will take place 16–21 August 2020 in Zurich (Switzerland). The symposium, organized by the International Association of GeoChemistry (IAGC) and hosted by ETH Zurich, will feature invited plenary talks from world-class speakers and extended poster sessions covering a wide range of cutting-edge research themes in the field of surface and environmental geochemistry.

This symposium will bring together experts in all fields of surface geochemistry and environmental geochemistry. The overarching theme of GES12 might be summed up as Earth system interactions on a changing planet.

The symposium aims to strengthen connections between research disciplines and to establish new networks.
