ELECTRONIC ACCESS

Starting in 2008, electronic access to the online version of *Elements* will be available on the *Elements* website at www.elementsmagazine.org. The online version contains all the material of the print version. If e-access to *American Mineralogist*, *Canadian Mineralogist* has been set up, we will use the same IP addresses for *Elements*.

Institutional subscribers to *Mineralogical Magazine*, *Clays and Clay Minerals*, *Clay Minerals* or *MinAbs Online* (which do not have a subscription to *American Mineralogist* or *Canadian Mineralogist*) should send the range of IP addresses covering their institution to j_a_speer@minsocam.org."
